On Wednesday, we'll set up the kitchen and the service area. On Thanksgiving Day, we'll pack meals for the homebound, and then we'll open our doors as we host a meal. On Friday, we'll make sure that everything is put back just as we found it. We're also in need of volunteers who are able to cook a turkey, sides, and/or a dessert at home and deliver it to the church. Between our two churches, we'll need about 30 turkeys to pull this off.
